# AVIATION MERIT BADGE PROGRAM

Want to earn your aviation merit badge?

Here's how:

First, study the badge requirements listed on the second page of this handout. They come straight from the Aviation Merit Badge handbook (© 2006). Your troop should have a copy of the handbook in its library. It is also available online at [Cavu Flight Academy](#).

For the requirements where you need to make a choice, we will be covering 2b, 2f, 3b and 4a. Notice that 3b involves building a model airplane. You do not need to do this beforehand. We will be doing it at the program.

Second, complete the written test provided to your leader. The test is emailed when you register. The completed, graded test, SIGNED BY YOUR SCOUTMASTER, needs to be brought to our program. The answer key will be mailed to your leader when they register for the program.

Third, come to our Youth Aviation Adventure program! This year's programs are: **Saturday, October 12<sup>st</sup>, 2013**. Programs is help at Executive Air at Austin Straubel Airport in Green Bay. The program runs from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. and consists of ten stations which cover the topics discussed in the Aviation Merit Badge handbook. You will spend about twenty minutes at each station and should come prepared to discuss each station's topic.

Admission to the program is \$5, which can be pre-paid online at [Cavu Flight Academy](#). Because most of the program is conducted indoors, it will be held regardless of weather. At the end of the program, you will have completed the requirements for your aviation merit badge. You do not need to bring a blue card to the program, we will provide them.
