



Aviation and Aerodynamics for Private and Sport Pilots

Appropriate for ages 16 and older!

This training is designed to help you understand the aerodynamic principles and physics of powered flight as well as to evaluate the exciting field of aviation as a career or hobby! This course prepares you for successfully passing the FAA Private Pilot or Sport Pilot written exam. Upon completion of the 9 week course, you will receive an endorsement to take the FAA Private Pilot or Sport Pilot Knowledge Test.



There is no required prerequisite for this course. Must be age 16 or older.

Schedule: This course will meet each Monday evening from 6:00-9:00 p.m. beginning February 13 and running through April 10, 2017.

Fee: \$300 for private or sport pilot
